AGENDA FOR WEEKLY REHEARSALS

We NEED regular assistance of Cadets and their parents at weekly practices!

There is a large amount of unloading and set-up required to prepare for the evening's band rehearsals. The more parents and students helping, the faster set-up will go. Many hands make light the work! Also please note below the **REQUIRED ARRIVAL TIME**. Any Cadets arriving at or just before 5:00 are already late!!!

- 1. Assist the parent helper in charge with setting-up chairs in the hall.
- 2. When that task is finished, help carry in any music files and remaining percussion equipment.
