# \*\*\*\*\*CADET PERFORMANCE\*\*\*\*\*

The Cadet Performance is May 2, upstairs in MARVIN HALL at Resurrection.

ALL band members must come dressed in CONCERT DRESS.

All cadets must **arrive no later than 4:15** for the concert to assist with unloading and set-up so they can be in their seats ready to play by 5:00 at which time we will tune the band. (See item above about help needed requiring earlier arrival time.) **CONCERT DRESS** includes a plain, button-front white shirt/blouse buttoned to the neck, and black pants/skirt and shoes. Refer to the Handbook, page 14, or the Dress Code on our Forms Documents page, for complete specifics regarding socks, panty hose and acceptable/unacceptable clothing styles. We will be observing your dress for compliance. **When you sit down, no leg should be showing.** A suggestion for those wearing pants, Walmart has <u>Black crew socks</u> sizes 4.5-8.5, 5 pairs for \$8.90

**AWARD RIBBONS:** Any/all award pins are worn on a red ribbon. If you need a red ribbon please see Mrs. WP before the concert starts. Red ribbons are worn on the left side.

# Notes to Junior, Senior, and Symphonic bands –

#### **ALL CONCERT BANDS - CONDUCT AT REMAINING PRACTICES**

For our remaining practices thru the Dress Rehearsal and Concert it is the director's goal to play through all songs without stopping. All band members, in every section, will be expected to conduct themselves as if they are at the Concert. Although we will not be in "Concert Dress", there is no reason we cannot behave as though we are. If we do this now it should make the actual dress rehearsal go very smoothly. This includes things such as:

- Make sure you have tuned before you sit down.
- Observe concert demeanor with **no talking**, as if on stage. This includes between songs too.
- Hold your instrument properly while waiting for the director to step on the podium.
- Sit erect and bring your instrument up as the director mounts the podium.
- Bring instrument to your mouth when director raises her arms.
- Sit upright on your chair, both feet on the floor, without your back touching the backrest while playing.
- Do not look around, hang your head down or slouch in your chair during long rests. You should sit still
  like a statue, facing the director. This is especially true during the solo performances in Symphonic. The
  slightest movements can be a distraction to the audience.

The song order below, for each band, is concert order.

ALL WIND PLAYERS – Put all sheet music in concert order NOW.

ALL PERCUSSIONISTS - Start putting music in all folders in concert order.

See the list under each band. Rehearsal on 5/9 is your last chance.

We will use podium etiquette at all rehearsals through the Concert

May 23 - THURSDAY AFTER CONCERT - Final Concert Season Meeting after the Spring Concert AND Official start of SUMMER MARCHING TRIMESTER which includes the FIRST MARCHING PRACTICE, THE ANNUAL INSTRUMENT INVENTORY/CHECK, MUSIC RETURN, CORPUS CHRISTI REHEARSAL and more.

All marching musicians are expected to participate in this preliminary marching practice.

to offer their services in the training of new marchers, also Senior or Symphonic band members interested in being a rank leader.

Attendance on this day **WILL NOT GUARANTEE** your role as a rank leader in marching camp or at parades.

The director will decide and assign rank leaders based on multiple criteria including: actual marching ability, leadership skills, marching camp attendance as well as prior AND current parade commitments.

June 6/17 through 6/21 – FULL MARCHING BAND CAMP at DuPage County Fair Grounds, 9am to 12pm each day. Enter off Manchester, via Gate S7 at the SE corner of the Fairgrounds

Elk Grove Village Hometown Parade – Saturday, September 21. Arrive no later than 1.
