- May 23 THURSDAY AFTER CONCERT CADETS MUST ATTEND WITH JR, SR, SYM
 - Official start of SUMMER MARCHING TRIMESTER
 - Percussionists must bring any equipment they have at home. It may be reassigned for the summer. ARRIVE AT 4:30 and to help Mrs. Borow prepare for drumline practice.
 - 5pm Marching percussion/drumline practice
 - Band members arrive at 6 PM to do returns, etc. CADETS MUST ALSO ATTEND !!!

MUSIC NOTES Cadets

CADET FAMILIES ARE INVITED TO CONCERT

Friday, May 17, 6:30pm, is the night of the Spring Concert at Edman Chapel at Wheaton College, Wheaton, IL. We hope you will be able to attend. If that date does not work you may attend the dress rehearsal on Thursday, May 16, 6pm, but you would need to through the door on the north side of the building, adjacent to the parking lot. On the night of the concert, only band members use this back door. All other family members and concertgoers must enter the auditorium through Edman's main

doors. We hope to see you there. If you come to the Concert, consider joining us at Portillo's afterwards.

Cadet families, be sure to continue to read the Rehearsal Notes.

VERY IMPORTANT- Cadets must come on May 23

May 23 is the final Concert Season Meeting after the Spring Concert AND official start of SUMMER MARCHING TRIMESTER. ALL CADETS MUST ATTEND. Band members arrive at 6:00pm to do returns, etc. All marching percussionists must arrive earlier at 5:00pm for Summer Marching drumline practice.

- 6:00 7:30pm Return completed Cadet Music Return Form along with sheet music for <u>Vandivere</u> <u>Fanfare, Dragon Slayer, and Dancin' on the Bayou</u>. The fine for any full size missing music is \$4.00. You are expected to pay your fines when you return your music. Come prepared to do so.
- MANDATORY Return/check-in (Cadets included) of all WSHSB rental/loaner instruments (whether keeping or returning) for the ANNUAL INSTRUMENT INVENTORY/CHECK.
- Return of any/all other band property
- Music filing/organizing by parent volunteers
- Approx. 7:30pm Cadets coming to marching camp MUST ATTEND on 5/23 for preliminary marching camp practice. Bring your instrument, lyre and flip-folder loaded with your music

Those not marching may leave after they have completed their return(s).

NOTE TO CADET PARENTS: The sooner you start this, the better. Review the Junior audition requirements with your student. It would be most productive to have them start practicing now. At the top of our Audition webpage see the document "Suggested Strategy for Auditioning." *Reminder:* Correctly performing rhythms is a large factor in audition results and overall progression as a musician. It is <u>essential</u> for those interested in placing higher within any band or moving up a band.

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# Notes to Junior, Senior, and Symphonic bands –

**CONCERT REMINDERS FOR ALL** 

- 1. Attention all Second Chair people All SECOND CHAIR people need to practice all solos in case the FIRST chair becomes ill and cannot make the concert.
- 2. Break in new reeds now Do not expect to perform well at the concert with a brand new reed. You must have a couple reeds already BROKEN-IN prior to the dress rehearsal. Have more than one ready in case of breakage.
- 3. Cummerbunds and bowties Cummerbunds and bow ties were distributed at practice on **May 9.** Band members must stop by the front table to pick up what is needed for their highest band. Everyone wears a bow tie. Concert Senior and Symphonic also wear a cummerbund. Do not just help yourself, but see one of the moms at the table.
- Review Dress Code and check fit of clothes NOW shirt, pants, etc Remember, FULL CONCERT DRESS is to be worn to Dress Rehearsal AND Concert and you will be observed for compliance. Mrs. WP wants to remind all of what our Dress code states –
   \*Only solid white or flesh-tone undergarments. Other colors show through.
   \*If wearing pants, you must wear black crew socks. When you sit down, no leg should be showing.
- 5. ANY BAND AWARDS that you want to wear on your uniform MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE RED AWARD RIBBON. Attach the red award ribbon to the top, left side of your shirt (or jacket) even with the point of your collar. Ribbon replacement fee is \$1. All awards must fit on ribbons!

There is an **EXCEPTION FOR ONLY SYMPHONIC GRADUATING SENIORS**; – You may wear awards anywhere on the upper left breast of the jacket, with no medal lower than the bottom edge of the pocket. Nothing should be on the collar, lapel or sleeve

- Lyre and Flip Folders needed for Concert Standing wind musicians from Junior, Senior and Symphonic need to use a lyre and flip-folder at the Spring Concert. Be sure to label. Under no circumstances should it be cut to fit! Rather photocopy and reduce it.
- 7. About those tapping feet The sound of people tapping their feet to help keep time can be very apparent during rehearsals in Cornelius Hall, which has a SOLID, CONCRETE floor. This sound is magnified when on a stage that is hollow underneath as at Edman. Just lift your toes and do not tap the ball of your foot.
