Everyone (All 3 bands) must:

- **REVIEW THE CONCERT DRESS CODE** at <u>WSHSB Dress Codes</u>. Check the fit of your concert dress clothes (band shirts/pants)
- <u>All three</u> bands must arrive by 4:30 to work-through logistics and be ready to play at 6pm.
- For both the dress rehearsal and concert, all band members Junior through Symphonic, must be on time, in Concert Dress and remain at Elmhurst Christian until the end of the dress rehearsal/concert.(i.e.: Symphonic has performed, God Bless, Encore, the END) No one is to leave prior to the END. While not performing on stage you must be in your designated seat/spot.

**DYNAMICS** - In general **ALL** our *mp*, *p* and *pp* dynamic markings must be played MUCH quieter.

We will use podium etiquette at all rehearsals through the Performance Director steps off podium – Instruments down Director steps on podium – Instruments upright, to one side Director raises arms – Instruments up in playing position

BRING TUNERS Section Leaders must bring your own tuner each week and tune your entire instrument section carefully BEFORE your band time begins.

## SOLO AND ENSEMBLE CONTEST (SEC) REGISTRATION ENDS 2/13

Our annual Solo and Ensemble Contest is an exciting and much anticipated musical event. Our 24th annual SEC will be held on a **Saturday, March 15, 2025, 9am to @2:30pm.** Location is Christ Presbyterian Church, 903 E. Nerge Rd., Roselle 60172. ALL band members, Cadet through Symphonic, are encouraged to participate in the SEC. Students have the opportunity to prepare solos and/or ensembles of their choice and perform them for a judge who then rates their performance. There is no competition; rather, students strive for their personal best. Judge's decisions are final. **SEC Online registration opened December 5 and ends February 13, 2025. All fees and Judging sheets are due by February 20, 2025**. Fees are **\$4** per person (excluding adults) whether solo or ensemble. All entries should not exceed **FIVE** minutes. You must indicate Solo or Ensemble on the registration. Only one person should register for an entire ensemble. If Ensemble is chosen, the form will then allow spaces for all participants' names, etc. A confirmation email will be sent for each entry to the main contact provided.
